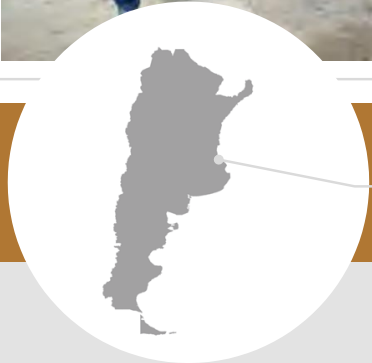

SCOPE: MUNICIPAL, CITY OF BUENOS AIRES

CONTEXT

PROBLEM

BUENOS AIRES HAS ABOUT 300,000 INHABITANTS IN SLUMS AND INFORMAL SETTLEMENTS THAT ARE NOT PART OF THE CITY'S MAPPING. THIS POPULATION DOES NOT HAVE GUARANTEED FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS AND SUFFERS SERIOUS SHORTAGES IN UTILITIES AND URBAN INFRASTRUCTURE.

PROJECT

IMPLEMENT A GEOREFERENCED TECHNOLOGICAL TOOL FOR THE COMMUNITY'S DIAGNOSIS OF DIFFERENT SERVICES PROVISION, MONITOR AND CONTROL OF PUBLIC WORKS IN SLUMS, AND SUPPORT TO CORRECT ANOTHER DEFICIT IN THESE PRECARIOUS NEIGHBORHOODS.

RESULTS

REACHED

- » ALL SLUMS IN THE CITY WERE INCORPORATED TO THE CARTOGRAPHY, REVERSING THEIR INVISIBILITY; PARTICIPATORY MAP BUILDING PROCESS;
- » 4 CITY SLUMS WHERE RESIDENTS CAN MONITOR THE URBANIZATION WORKS IN PROGRESS: VILLA 20, VILLA 31, RODRIGO BUENO AND PLAYÓN CHACARITA;
- » ESTABLISHMENT OF A TRANSPARENCY TOOL TO MONITOR AND EVALUATE URBANIZATION PROCESSES;
- » STRENGTHENING THE ORIENTATION OF PUBLIC POLICY AND URBAN DESIGN TOWARDS A PERSPECTIVE ON RIGHTS AND RESPECT.

EXPECTED

- » REPLICATE THE SOLUTION AND THE TOOL ON OTHER SLUMS IN THE CITY OF BUENOS AIRES, IN ARGENTINA AND IN LATIN AMERICA.
